1. Update P2 in Contracting Pamphlet

3. Prepare a blanket statement regarding P2 compliance to be placed in template.

Statement:

Contracts are vehicles through which the Government can insure that contractors are in compliance with P2/ESOH objectives. Consequently, contracts and RFPs for design, development, and production should contain SOWs/performance specifications, which require ESH tasks/effort. Further source-selection criteria should be included in Sections L and M of the RFP requiring offerors to describe environmental considerations in their proposals. These considerations should include (at a minimum) compliance with all applicable P2/ESOH statutes and regulations, hazardous materials minimization, pollution prevention actions, and how these will be incorporated into system design, manufacturing, and supportability.

4. P2 in Maintenance and Repair Contracting Guide

Statement 1: Ship repair and maintenance is a complex and demanding job. Innate contractor managerial, technical, safety and environmental skill are necessary in order to satisfactorily complete the repair and maintenance effort in a sustainable compliance with environmental laws and regulations. To assist and define specific Environmental, Safety and Occupational Health (ESOH) government contract work solicitation requirement, the title of a Site Specific ESOH Guide containing Pollution Prevention in Maintenance and Repair Contracting Information is added to Section J, List of attachments. The intent of this template is to simplify the ESOH requirements by pulling out the existing ESOH clauses that already appear in the other section of the contract and combining them together in one template. This is in addition to new ESOH requirement that has been developed and approved for solicitation.

Statement 2: Develop a Draft SEA 00T letter recommending Field Activities develop ESOH guides for inclusion in Maintenance and Repair contracting.
