Subj: CORPORATE MATERIAL PAT (CMP) AFTER ACTION REPORT #9

1. Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard hosted the Corporate Material PAT (CMP) meeting at Pearl Harbor, HI, 25 through 27 February 2003. CMP attendees were Code 200 and Code 500 members from each Naval Shipyard (NSY) as well as other NSY material stakeholders from activities including NAVSUP, NAVICP, and DLA. Executive summary highlights of the CMP sessions are outlined in enclosure (1). Highlights from the previous meeting are outlined in enclosure (2); lists attendees in enclosure (3); and active action items being worked by the group are provided in enclosure (4).
2. This was the ninth CMP meeting since the team's inception approximately three years ago. The CMP's efforts focus on NSY material management process improvement that includes the engagement of many external stakeholders on material support issues. The group has been extremely successful engaging the broader supply support community on systemic supply/material issues as well as working within the NSY community on internal material processes to improve cost, schedule, and quality of our depot maintenance mission with respect to material management.
3. The next CMP is planned for 17-19 June at Mechanicsburg, PA, to include attendance from the SEA/SUP Management Oversight Board (MOB). The development and evolution of an Assistant Chief of Staff (ACOS) for Industrial Support is a key milestone in the SEA/SUP partnership that requires the engagement of all industrial support stakeholders, and a CMP meeting hosted at Mechanicsburg will be a good formal start.
