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

SUBJECT: POM Projections Regarding the Standard Procurement System

As we continue to deploy and sustain the Standard Procurement System (SPS) across the DoD procurement community, please ensure that you are projecting adequate funding to support deployment and sustainment in your POM submissions for FY04-FY09. It is essential that the Service and Agencies' continue to provide the necessary hardware, operating software, and connectivity configuration at deployed and deploying sites. Additionally, the Services and Agencies should include those costs associated with any unique site installation, training, interface development and support, and other maintenance costs not covered by the baseline SPS program.

Finally, as the PSA I have also initiated a joint effort with the Service Components to develop the concept of operations for Defense Procurement. As this CONOPS is developed, the Services and Agencies should assess their program funding to support the resulting architectures.
