Litton-Avondale Industries, Inc., P.O. Box 50280, New Orleans, Louisiana 70150, is being awarded a Cost-Plus-Incentive Fee Option in the amount of \$477,675,955.00 for the construction of the LPD 20. Work will be performed in New Orleans, Louisiana (83%); San Diego, California (12.2%); Bath, Maine (0.2%); and Waynesboro, Virginia (4.6%); and is expected to be completed by December 2004. Contract funds will not expire at the end of the current fiscal year. The Naval Sea Systems Command, Arlington, Virginia, is the contracting activity.

Further Explanation of Contract:

The LPD 17 Class Amphibious Transport Dock Ship is used for amphibious warfare. The ships load, transport and off-load troops, heavy vehicles, helicopters, landing craft, amphibious vehicles, and both dry and liquid cargo. This contract modification results in the full funding of the construction of the LPD 20, the fourth ship of the LPD 17 Class. Funding is SCN (100%).
